On behalf of the New Hampshire National Guard, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services and our Veteran Program Partners, I invite you to participate in an *Outreach, Education & Service Delivery Initiative* for New Hampshire Veterans. The vehicle for this outreach and education is 2-1-1 NH, an easy to remember 3-digit phone number to dial for information about health and human services organizations in New Hampshire. 2-1-1 is a free, confidential, 24/7 referral helpline with language translation in over 150 languages as well as TTY service.

Since launching this program in June of 2008, 2-1-1 NH has connected over 19,000 NH residents with community services that they did not know existed. Our goal for this initiative is to make sure that our veterans, service members and their families have an easy way of learning about the important programs and services available to them.

As part of this *Outreach, Education and Service Delivery Initiative*, WMUR Channel 9 will be airing a 30-second Public Service Announcement in October of 2009 to introduce 2-1-1 NH and their ability to connect services to veterans, service members and their families with programs and services that can meet their current and future needs.

In partnership with the NH New Hampshire National Guard, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services and our Veteran Program Partners, I encourage you to participate in this important initiative. Prior to launching the PSA campaign, we want to make sure that the 2-1-1 data base has a comprehensive listing of programs that serve (or could serve) our Veteran population. Please review your agency listing at [www.211nh.org](http://www.211nh.org) to ensure it includes all of your programs and services. Use the forms under the "Agency Tools" tab to add or change data or establish a new profile. If you have any questions, please dial 2-1-1 and ask for Tina or Heather. If you already have a profile in the 2-1-1 NH database, you can call Tina at 2-1-1 to request a login and password to make changes electronically.
